Safer Neighbourhoods

Residents are concerned about young people loitering and engaging in arson and graffiti. I want to see effective community policing with safer neighbourhood teams on duty around the clock, not just certain points in the day. Enfield Green Party will also push to open more police stations, put more police on the beat, and support Safer Neighbourhood panels and independent Community groups. I also want to see better street lighting in the local area, with more staff and caretakers at Bush Hill Park railway station and at surrounding parks.

Green New Deal for Energy

I want grants for every household to insulate their homes and install solar panels. Enfield Council has earmarked £2.3m to help households in its draft budget. If elected I would put pressure on the council to use this money to help households become more energy efficient, reduce their gas and electricity bills and lower their carbon emissions.

Twenty's Plenty

Residents are concerned about speeding motorists in local streets. Enfield Green Party is calling for a borough wide 20mph speed limit. Research shows that a 20mph speed limit would dramatically reduce the numbers of deaths and serious injuries on our roads. As a Green Party councillor I will urge Enfield Council to introduce a 20mph speed limit on all residential roads.

Local Shops and Services

Empty shops in Bush Hill Park could be used to provide a better range of services for the local community, such as grocers selling quality fresh vegetables. If elected, I would pressure Enfield Council to support and encourage new small businesses with reduced rates and a 'shop local' campaign. I would also fight to safeguard the future of the local Post Office and push to increase its range of services.
