We've been out listening to Bowes residents. Here are some things you've said, we'd like to respond to:

**"I'd like to vote Green, but I don't want to waste my vote"** Last time round, Greens were just 100 votes short of getting elected in Bowes. We are planning to WIN this May and with your votes we can. Vote for our Green team in Bowes, Laura, Jack and Peter.

**"Labour doesn't deserve my vote but is there a better option?"**

Greens stands for a different way of doing things. We believe community counts and will

listen and respond to you. Greens in Bowes have worked for better results on the A406 road scheme, local housing and traffic calming. We're active in the community year in year out. As councillors we can do even more.

**"I know the Greens want to stop climate change but how will you make a difference in Bowes?"** We believe in acting responsibly, working together to support our families, communities and planet. Green councillors would work to:

- Give Bowes a community centre with facilities for all ages.

As a councillor, Jack aims to be a thorn in the side of Enfield council. With local roots, educated at Southgate School, he is passionate about local quality of life. Local shops for instance. *"Green Lanes and Bowes Road should be thriving shopping centres for Bowes, but since the banks closed, I'm worried that so many shops are to let at the same time. The council needs to listen to our ideas for supporting the local economy."*

But Jack also takes a wider global view. He joined the Green Party in 2002 due to its consistent stand against the impending Iraq invasion, and includes political heavyweights George Orwell, John Pilger and Noam Chomsky among his influences. *"Quite simply, we have got stuck in a consumerist*

**A406 major road works**

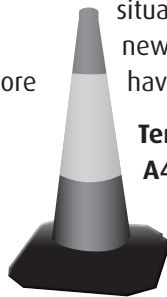

**A question –**

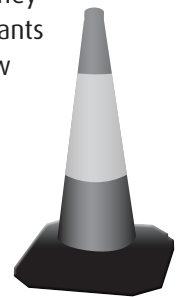
