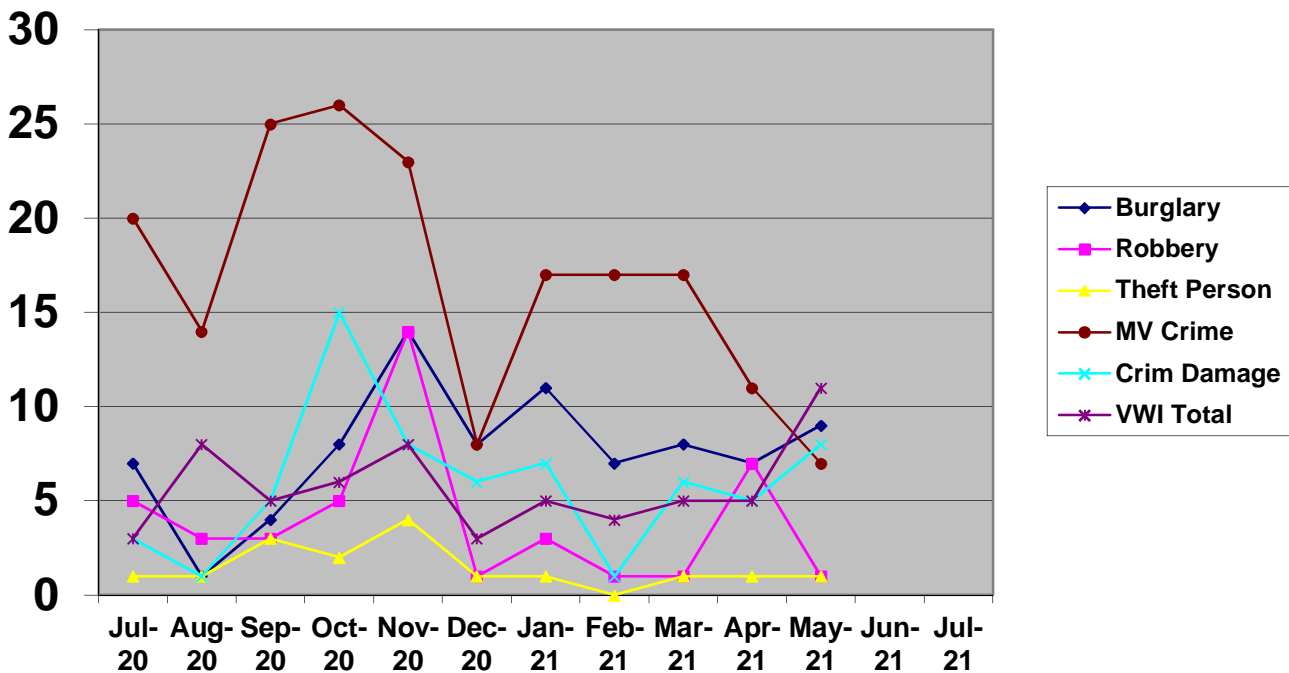


Safer Neighbourhood News

Welcome to this month's newsletter.
The team have been very busy over the last month patrolling generally but concentrating on burglary and robbery hotspot areas and working revised shifts covering evenings and early mornings, burglary continues to be a problem as it is very hard to predict where the suspects may strike next.

MV = Motor vehicle crime
VWI = Violence with Injury (Assault)

- P**ay attention to strangers loitering call police if you have any concerns
- R**emove items of value from your vehicle when it is unattended
- O**nly let expected visitors and work people into your home legitimate callers will be more than happy to wait whilst you check out their validity
- T**reat unexpected callers at the door with caution if unsure don't open the door
- E**nsure you use door and window locks
- C**heck your home security regularly
- T**alk to your dedicated ward officer if you need any advice re home or vehicle security

Crimes Recorded in May

Burglary

There were **4** residential burglaries, **4** non – residential burglaries, **1** attempted residential burglary, **0** attempted non - residential burglaries and **0** aggravated burglaries reported in May.

Suspect believed to have entered via fire exit, computer equipment stolen.

Suspect believed to have entered via fire exit, computer equipment stolen.

Protect your vehicle from catalytic converter thieves

If you can, park your vehicle in a locked garage when it is unattended.

If it's not possible to garage your vehicle, park it in a busy, well-lit area as close to your property as possible.

Consider installing a Thatcham approved alarm to your Vehicle, ones that activate if your vehicle is lifted or tilted are particularly effective.

Use a catalytic converter protection device or marking system.

Catalytic converters control and convert exhaust emissions from your vehicle into less toxic substances. If yours is stolen, you will know because your vehicle's engine will sound different.

If you suspect your catalytic converter has been stolen, report it to us immediately by calling 101.
