CHARITH SAYS "COP26 WAS A MISSED OPPORTUNITY"

The failure of global leaders to agree firm actions to achieve new green jobs, guarantee a just transition and help fund climate action was a missed opportunity at COP26.

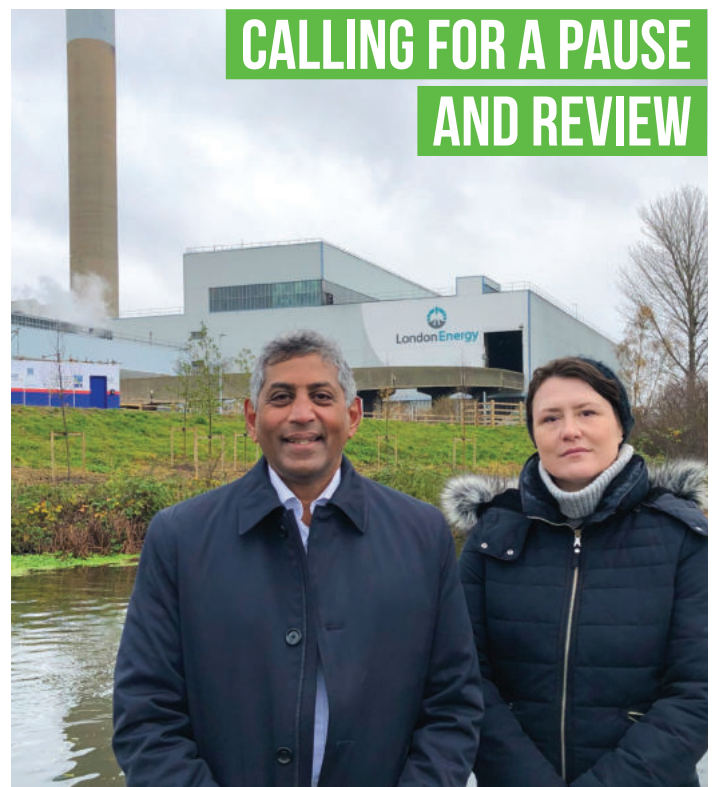
There is now an urgent need to treat the climate crisis as the emergency it really is at both national and local levels. The UK government must release the necessary funds to make this possible. The time for greenwashing is now firmly over.

Enfield Council can do more by insulating its housing stock, protecting the green belt, implementing a fair, green transport strategy, increasing recycling rates, planting more street trees, considering carbon tax for high polluting vehicles and not burning waste.

Charith backs Georgia Elliott Smith, who led a legal challenge to UK's exclusion of incinerators from emission targets and said **"Enfield should reject the expansion of an incinerator** costing over £1bn to burn large amounts of recyclable waste generated from across London. **Why are we causing more air pollution in one of the poorest wards of the borough** where the Meridian Water regeneration scheme plans to add a further 30,000 more people?" ●

SOUTHGATE IS LOSING ITS STREET TREES

Charith calls for an updated urban street tree strategy

Southgate and Southgate Green wards saw a **net loss of trees last year.**

There are many reasons as to why trees have to be removed – disease, safety, causing damage, development and so on. The council’s current strategy is to replace trees when removed.

Unfortunately, the often majestic and mature trees are replaced with saplings.

Charith said “Local residents would like to see a tree planting plan to ensure there are more mature trees across the ward **creating greener neighbourhoods and spaces for the future.**” ●



Cllr Gunawardena said “This tree was removed recently off Chelmsford Road, but residents have not seen a visible replacement nearby.”

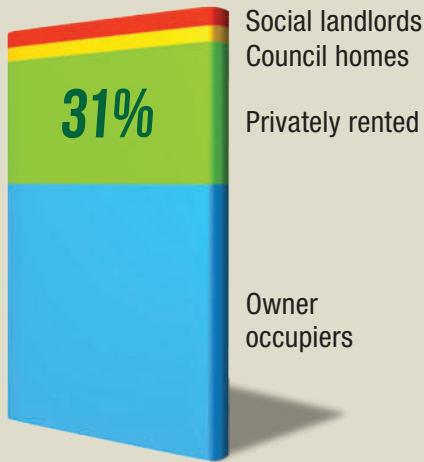

Over 5,000 households



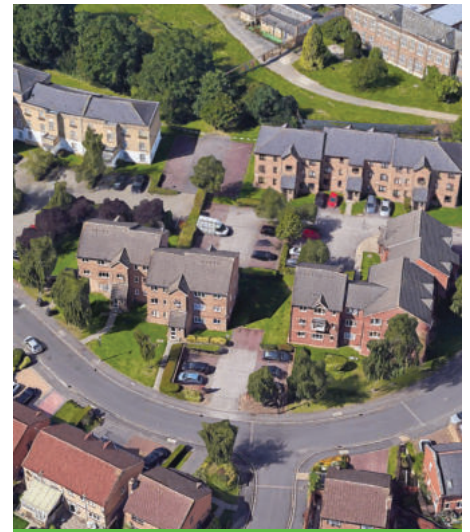
SOUTHGATE NEEDS LANDLORD LICENSING

CHARITH WANTS “BETTER CONDITIONS FOR RENTERS”

Private rented property licensing schemes have been introduced by Enfield Council in some parts of the borough to improve property conditions and management standards.

The schemes also help to reduce deprivation and the antisocial behaviour (ASB) that is sometimes associated with the private rented sector in the borough.

Charith said “With about 30% of dwellings in Southgate privately rented, tenants living in the ward would also benefit from such a scheme. **I call for the scheme to be extended to Southgate without delay.**” ●
